

About Via Molina

Via Molina – The European Mill Route e.V. was founded by law in 2018 by national mill organizations in Denmark, Germany and the Netherlands. Via Molina wants to make mill routes accessible to the public throughout Europe.



The Via Molina cultural route is linked to the monuments of the mill. The hiking, cycling and car routes along the mills routes often take you through beautiful landscapes, beautiful historical cities and villages and take you to hidden mill spots. Due to their exposed location, the mills are landmarks for tourism and local recreation. Via Molina is currently prequalified for the certification of the cultural route of the council of europe.

Terms and Conditions

The registered office of the Association shall be in Minden, Germany and It shall exist for an indefinite period of time. Via Molina is an international non-profit association with the purpose to explore and preserve mill constructions in the respective partner countries, bring them to the general public's attention and facilitate access to them.

The association aims at a further development and design of the network concept. Via Molina supports the professional qualification and further education of its members and their staff or volunteers. Identity-building measures in the respective partner regions are cultural events, art projects and education for children, youth and adults.

The costs of operating and developing the Via Molina cultural route are shared between the member associations according to a financial formula. Bodies of the Association are the General Meeting and the Board, which consists of the chairperson, the deputy chairperson, the treasurer and other Board members.
